

## Use of PE and Sport Premium 2013/14



### Background

The dedicated primary PE and Sport Premium which was announced in March 2013 and began the following September, goes directly to primary school head teachers so that they can decide how best to use it to provide sporting activities for pupils.

### Our School

We have received £8986 PE and Sport Premium funding. We have also allocated money from the school budget. The main focus of the spending is swimming. Swimming was recognised as a need for our pupils as the majority are unable to swim 25metres. In a parent survey completed in the autumn term 2013, the majority of parents who responded indicated that they would be interested in extra swimming lessons.
