SCHOOL

As a school, we will:

- Provide a child led and inspirational curriculum for all children that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Explore a wide variety of concepts that promotes mutual respect and tolerance of the diverse community we live in;
- Ensure that learning is engaging and collaborative with children acquiring knowledge to build on;
- Provide rich experiences to enable all pupils' access to the same learning opportunities;
- Provide all our learners with outcome driven, enquiry-based tasks which promote independent thinking and enable them to demonstrate understanding;
- Promote critical thinking through links with concepts and providing opportunities or skills that enable depth in understanding;
- Support children with corrective learning opportunities that ensures all children can achieve;
- Encourage children to reflect and evaluate on their learning to drive improvement and take ownership of next steps;
- Develop personal skills through the explicit and targeted teaching of the school's values;
- Ensure that parents know procedures for expressing any concerns.
- Ensure that all the school community is aware of safeguarding children and child protection procedures;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email, Facebook and the school website.

PARENT

As a parent /carer, I will:

- Encourage my child in their learning and offer support;
- Encourage my child to become an independent, resilient learner who take responsibility for their personal organisation;
- Attend parent evenings to discuss my child's learning;
- Ensure my child arrives on time and that they attend school regularly and I will inform the school of any absence and avoid taking holidays in term time;
- Inform the school of anything which, I feel, may be affecting my child's learning;
- Share any concerns I have by talking to the class teacher, in the first instance, and then senior staff if appropriate;
- Support the school's expectations of behaviour;
- Treat all staff, other parents and children with respect and courtesy;
- Not comment on the school, individual staff, children or parents on social network sites;
- Ensure that my child will not bring any items into school with them except for their packed lunch, PE kit and school work;
- Support all staff in their efforts to create a safe environment at school;
- Read **all** letters, messages and emails that are sent home;
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- Send in a letter or inform the school office if my child will be picked up by someone else.
- Ensure that I am always aware of my child's online activity, even if it is out of school time.

CHILD

As a child, I will:

- Behave in a positive and sensible way and keep to the school rules at all times to keep myself and others safe;
- Respect the feelings of other children and adults, **including on-line (in school and after school)** and co-operate with others;
- Work with others in my class and will take into account that others will have different views to mine;
- Take time to reflect on my learning and will ask questions about the world around me;
- Consider any challenges in my learning and work at ways to overcome this;
- Be resilient and foster a positive attitude in all that I do
- Take pride in my work and try my best;
- Share my learning with those at home and encourage conversation about it;
- Tell someone if I have worries that are making me or someone else unhappy;
- Take pride in my school and the environment and will help look after it;
- Not bring things into school from home, except for my packed lunch, PE kit and school work or take things home from school with me.
